OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Modification of Guidelines for Selection of Assistant Professor / Librarian in Provincialised Colleges of Assam as per UGC guidelines, excluding the criteria of awarding oral marks.

In partial modification of this Deptt.'s earlier OM issued vide No.AHE.262/2012/13 dated 25-06-2012 the last para :

a) Teaching Experience - 5 marks (1 mark for each complete year of service in an affiliated or Govt. Degree College subject to maximum 5 marks) will be replaced by :

2. Teaching Experience (maximum 5 marks) : Teaching Experience shall carry 1 mark for each completed year of service. However, 11 months or more but less than a year, of continuous teaching shall also entail 1 mark. Teaching Experience marks will be awarded for teaching in the following category of institutes namely :

a) Teaching in a Degree College (Govt./Provincialised or Venture) but Affiliated to a University.

b) Teaching in Engineering Colleges imparting Degree BE/B.Tech having affiliation to Universities in Assam.

c) Teaching in State/Central Universities recognised by UGC and appearing in the consolidated list of Universities of the UGC Website.

d) Teaching experience will only be counted for teaching imparted after having acquired the eligibility for the post of Assistant Professor and not earlier. Period spent on teaching without acquiring eligibility shall not be counted.

e) Teaching a B.Ed. Colleges/Other Professional Colleges will be considered.

f) Period of time taken by a candidate to pursue M.Phil and Ph.D degree will not be counted as teaching experience as the State Govt. is yet to adopt the UGC letter dated 01-03-2016.

The following will be inserted in Para 3 of the O. M. .

3. Marks for M.Phil/Ph.D:

There shall be 7 marks for Ph.D. A candidate claiming exemption from NET/SLET for having acquired Ph.D shall not be awarded marks for Ph.D.

Ph.D and M.Phil if acquired in off campus mode shall not entail any marks. For award of marks under this head, the M.Phil and Ph.D degrees must have been acquired in consonance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standard & Procedure for award of M.Phil/Ph.D degree Regulation 2009/2016 whichever in force at the time of registration.

A candidate having Ph.D & M.Phil will get marks for Ph.D only and not for both. Permanent Resident Certificate for employment may not be insisted but proficiency in local language is compulsory.

The other terms and conditions as laid down in the OM vide No.AHE.262/2012/13 dated 25-06-2012 shall remain the same.


