BRIEF PROFILE OF THE ORGANISATIONS :

The **J.B College** is a premier educational institution in the north-east India situated in Jorhat. The college provides quality education offering Bachelor and Master Degrees. The Institute has already been accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2011 and awarded "A" grade on the basis of its performance in the field of higher education. Moreover it has been identified as a college with potential for excellence.

OBJECTIVE :

The main objective is to organize programme on Entrepreneurship and Skill Development. The outcome is expected to encourage educated youth to find new avenues for self-employment.

2. Facilitating in organizing the programme as per the guidelines of Development Commissioner, Ministry of MSME, Government of India


**ROLE OF CAREER COUNSELLING CENTRE,

This MoU may be renewed by mutual consent of both the institutions if the parties so desired or mutually agreed terms.






