# Research Policy Of Jagannath Barooah College(Auto)

The college has a definite research policy that aims to create and support a culture of research among the faculty members and students to motivate them for more research activities and take all the necessary steps to create a better environment in the college. The college has a plan to create an institutional fund to facilitate their participation in research activities and provide the required resources and appropriate facilities.

# **Policy Scope**

This policy shall apply to all the researchers of the college and for this policy 'researchers' are defined to include

- 1. All faculty members;
- 2. All students enrolled in the college;
- 3. All mentors, sponsors associated with any of the research activities of the college
- 4. All academic departments of the college;

### This policy shall apply to

- 1. Research activities including fundamental, strategic and applied research undertaken either for fulfilling the requirements of academic degrees or for solving problems;
- 2. Scholarly activities intended to expand knowledge boundaries by analysis, synthesis, and interpretation of ideas and information by making use of rigorous methodologies;
- 3. Knowledge compilation and communication initiatives for keeping abreast of academic developments in any knowledge domain such as the writing of books, book chapters, monographs and developing/updating curriculum;
- 4. Creative activities involving the generation of new ideas, innovations, hypotheses, images, performances or artifacts;
- 5. Research projects of students;
- **6.** Research publication, presentation, and communication;

### **Objectives**

- To create a research fund for providing seed money to faculty members and students
- To frame rules, procedures, and guidelines for granting research projects
- To develop guidelines for granting study leave and reduction in workload for faculty members undertaking research activities
- To identify and inform researchers about the appropriate research opportunities announced by different academic, research, industry or government organizations
- To promote interdisciplinary research
- To define an enabling framework for researchers to obtain sponsorships for research projects
- To identify and establish linkages including MOUs for long-term relationships with national and international research organizations.

- To identify and establish linkages including MOU s for long-term relationships with industrial bodies.
- To encourage the publication of the research papers in reputed academic journals.
- To encourage and facilitate the presentation/communication of the research work/projects as well as their findings and recommendations through academic events such as workshops/seminars/guest lectures or the media
- To form a database for easy monitoring and analysis of the progress being made by them from year to year
- To adopt an ethical code of research.

#### **Research Committee**

Research Committee will have the following composition

- Principal Chairperson
- Coordinator Member Secretary
- Six teachers Members

# **Mechanism for Policy Implementation**

The Research Committee of the college shall be responsible for implementing this policy of the college

The roles and functions of the research committee will be as follows

- 1. Facilitate the faculty in undertaking research and will work with the college management to set up a research fund for providing seed money
- 2. Provide research facilities regarding laboratory equipment, research journals, and research incentives, etc. required by the faculty.
- 3. Encourage and promote a research culture (e.g., teaching workload remission, opportunities for attending conferences, etc.).
- 4. Encourage the faculty to research by collaborating with other research organizations/industry.
- 5. Create suitable procedures for giving due recognition for guiding research.
- 6. Encourage departments to form university recognized research centers.
- 7. Facilitate the establishment of specific research units/ centers by funding agencies/university.
- 8. Organise workshops/ training programmes/ sensitization programmes to promote a research culture.
- 9. Budget preparation for supporting students' research projects.
- 10. Invite industry and other persons to use the research facilities of the college and sponsor research projects.
- 11. Approach National and international organizations for funding major and minor research projects undertaken by the faculty/students
- 12. Facilitate Interdepartmental / interdisciplinary research projects.

- 13. Frame an official Code of Ethics to check malpractices and plagiarism in research
- 14. Encourage and promote the publication of research papers by the faculty in reputed/refereed journals.
- 15. Publicise the research expertise and consultancy capabilities available in the college.
- 16. Prepare Rules & Guidelines for Grant of Research related leave and other remissions
- 17. Facilitate the provision of consultancy services to industries / Government / Non-Government organizations/community/ public.
- 18. Create incentives for the faculty who receive state, national and international recognition for research contributions as well as research awards and recognition from reputed professional bodies and agencies.
- 19. Prepare Guidelines for design and evaluation of curriculum oriented research projects.
- 20. Maintain a database of research work and research projects undertaken by the faculty and students.
- 21. Introduce research awards.
