### 19. A brief report of IQAC during the year 2010-2011: A brief report of IQAC during the period:

The IQAC, J. B. College has initiated a process that involves knowing the expectations, aspirations and needs of different cross sections of the society through the mechanism of feedback, seeking suggestion and opinion from stakeholders on the issue before spelling out the reframed vision and
