The 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council JB College (Autonomous) is held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2018. The Chairman Dr. Bimal Barah welcomes the members. Before explaining the objectives of the meeting, Member Secretary, Porag Sarmah introduced Prof. Pankaj Das, the new nominee of the honourable V.C Dibrugarh University.

Principal, Dr. Bimal Barah presented a brief report of the autonomous status of the college in which he highlighted achievements as well as challenges faced by the institute. He suggested that the autonomous status conferred on the college by UGC has provided opportunities to grow.

The Chairmen of the Board of Studies of different departments placed the resolutions and decisions adopted in their respective BoS meeting for approval of the Academic Council. Captain Juri Bhuyan, the Coordinator of the newly proposed NCC GE Course presented a brief report of the preparation made by her team for introduction of the proposed GE course in NCC. The report also included a sketch of the syllabus of this course.

The Controller of Examination, Dr. Sankar Das presented a report on results of end semester examinations held so far under CBCS. He reported that though the performance of the students in examination held in the initial semester under CBCS has not been satisfactory in comparison with earlier performance under affiliating mode, the graph of performance is gradually moving upward in successive semesters.

The Academic Council after threadbare discussion on different items in the agenda and reports presented in the meeting adopted the following resolutions.

#### **Resolution No1:**

Resolved that, as recommended by the committee constituted under the chairmanship of Captain Juri Bhuyan to study and report on possibility of introducing NCC as a subject and as per UGC letter No D.O.No.F.1 4-2512016(CPP-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> November 2016, NCC be introduced as a Generic Elective subject with an intake capacity of 30 students from the academic session 2018-19.

#### **Resolution No 2:**

Resolved that, as per the growing demand of the students the honours programme in Sociology be introduced from the academic session 2019-20 and for that purpose necessary ground work including designing of the syllabus be made well ahead.

#### **Resolution No 3:**

Resolved that, as designed and recommended by the Board of Studies of the departments of Assamese, Economics, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Sanskrit, Botany, Electronics, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, Zoology and Commerce the syllabus of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semester of under graduate classes be approved.

#### **Resolution: 4**

Resolved that, the Clause 9 of Rule 8 of Annexure -: I (Guidelines for Paper Setters) of JB College Examination Rules 2016 amended whereby Question Paper Setters of all courses of Science and Commerce Streams should be instructed to set question papers only in English, while the language provision for question Setters of Arts stream will stand unchanged.
